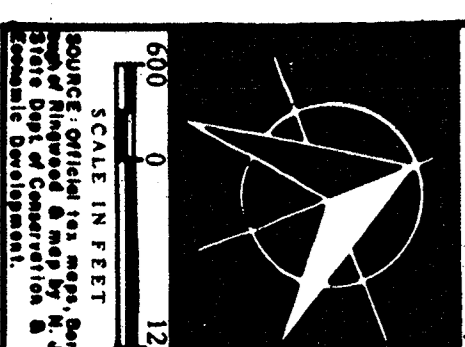
LAND USE PLAN
