BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Ringwood that Chapter 7 – Traffic, Article 39 – Handicapped Parking, Section 39.2 – Handicapped Parking on Streets for Private Residence be amended to include a designated handicapped parking space in front of the following private residence home:
