Persons holding the above positions shall, if otherwise qualified, be entitled to certain benefits provided in the collective bargaining agreement between the United Public Service Employees Union (Guild) or the Police Benevolent Association and the Borough of Ringwood, specifically including, but not necessarily limited to, vacation, sick, and hospitalization.
