Bogert Municipal Annex, 60 Margaret King Avenue, Ringwood, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested therein or affected thereby will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning same. During the week prior and up to the time of public hearing, copies of said Ordinance will be available to the members of the general public who request same.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ringwood, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 7-44.1 Parking Permits Required; Display of Permit shall be amended as follows:

No vehicle shall be parked in an area designated “Park and Ride Commuter Parking Area” unless it displays a valid and current parking permit issued by the Borough Clerk. **[ADD]** The Borough of Ringwood is not responsible for any damage incurred in the Ringwood Park & Ride.

[ADD] The permit must be fixed to the bottom left corner of the driver’s side passenger window.

Section 7-44.2 Issuance of Permits, Fees Transferability shall be amended to modify the permit fees as follows:

- a. *Application for Permit.* A parking permit shall be issued annually for the period May 1 to April 30 upon application to the Borough Clerk and only upon the display of a current and valid motor vehicle registration certificate for all household vehicles showing the name and address of the applicant and proof of insurance coverage.
- b. *Permit fee.*
 1. Fees shall be one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) per annum. The yearly permit runs May 1 to April 30. **[DELETE** Upon request by permittee, the Borough Clerk shall refund a pro rata balance of the annual fee if there are waiting applicants – no waiting applicants and it’s too cumbersome]
 2. For any permit issued for a six-month period, the fee for the six months shall be eighty dollars (\$80.00). The first six month period is May 1 – October 31. The second six month period is November 1 – April 30.

3. For any permit issued on a quarterly basis, the fee for each quarter shall be forty-five dollars (\$45.00). The first quarter is May 1 – July 31; the second quarter is August 1 – October 31; the third quarter is November 1 – January 31; and the fourth quarter is February 1 – April 30.
 4. For any permits issued on a monthly basis, the fee for the month shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00). The month starts on the first of the month and ends on the last day of the same month.
 5. For any permit issued on a weekly basis, the fee for any week shall be ten dollars (\$10.00). A weekly permit is Monday through Sunday.
- c. *Permit Nontransferable.* Parking permit shall be issued to the household and shall be nontransferable to persons outside that household.
 - d. *Sale or Purchase of Vehicle.* Applicant shall notify Borough Clerk of any deletions or additions of household vehicles.
 - e. *Contents of Permit.* All parking permits shall have written thereon "Borough of Ringwood Parking Permit" together with the number of the permit.
 - f. *Records.* The Borough Clerk shall keep a record of all permits by number, date of issuance, name and address of person to whom issued, make, model, color and year of the motor vehicle for which issued.

7-44.4 Day Parking

Day parking shall be by appointment only. Applicant shall contact the Borough Clerk, in person, by phone or email to request a day parking permit. Applicant will provide information regarding the vehicle being used for that day to the Borough Clerk.

The Borough Clerk may permit parking as provided in this subsection for a limited period of time greater than one (1) day, under special and exceptional circumstances.

7-44.5 Hours of Parking

After a parking permit has been affixed to the motor vehicle, the applicant may park the motor vehicle in the area provided; within the lines established for the parking of one (1) motor vehicle, daily throughout the year, except between the hours of 2:00 am and 5:00 am. If a permit-bearing vehicle is to remain in the lot between 2:00 am and 5:00 am, the owner shall notify the Police Department.

Parking shall be limited to a private passenger car, vans, and those trucks not exceeding one and one-half (1½) tons, (7,500 RGWV [Registered Gross Vehicle Weight]).

7-44.6 Lottery

If the number of applicants shall exceed the number of spaces available, the Borough Clerk will hold a lottery among the applicants. The lottery will be in three sections:

1. Spaces allotted for residents of Ringwood.
2. Spaces allotted for the general public.
3. Handicapped parking spaces.

The resident's lottery will be held first. Applicants of residents who lose the resident's lottery will be placed in the general public lottery. Remaining applications will be held and additional lotteries will be performed throughout the year for any cancelation of parking permits.

7-44.7 Lost Permits; Replacement Fee

In the event that any permit shall be lost, mislaid or destroyed, the holder of such permit shall make application to the Borough Clerk for the issuance of a substitute. The charge for the issuance of a substitute permit shall be ten dollars (\$10.00).

7-44.8 Penalty

The penalty for failing to display permit upon a vehicle shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) fine.
