AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 26-
QUARRIES - OF THE REVISED GENERAL
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF
RINGWOOD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY TO DELETE SUBPARAGRAPH
(b) - NOTICE OF VIOLATION - OF SECTION
26-13

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Ringwood, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, that Section 26-13 "Enforcement and Penalties" of Chapter 26 - Quarries - of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Ringwood is amended as follows:

1. Subparagraph b - Notice of Violation - is hereby deleted.
2. This ordinance is deemed severable and in the event any part hereof is declared void by a court of competent jurisdiction the rest and remainder shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage by the Municipal Council upon passage and publication as required by law.
