NOTICE is hereby given that the ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed first reading at a Business Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Borough of Ringwood, in the County of Passaic, New Jersey held at the Violet E. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11 - PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS - OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RINGWOOD TO PROVIDE FOR A RECREATION FEE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5.00 TO BE DEDICATED TO CAPITAL AND/OR MAINTENANCE IMPROVEMENT OF RECREATION FACILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Ringwood, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey that Chapter 11 - Parks and Recreation Areas - of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Ringwood is amended as follows:

1. New Section 11-5.3 - Recreation Capital Improvement Fee.

Contained within the recreation registration fees as set forth above, there shall be a sum of \$5.00 per program which shall be dedicated to a capital and/or maintenance improvement fund of the recreation facilities. Said \$5 fee shall be segregated into an account for its stated purpose.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after adoption.
