Lot Coverage shall mean the percentage of a lot area which is occupied by buildings and accessory structures including swimming pools, porches, decks, chimneys and other related building appurtenances but not including walkways, driveways, patios, tennis courts, open parking areas and loading areas.

Improved Lot Coverage shall mean the percentage of lot area which is improved with principal and accessory buildings, structures and uses including, but not limited to, driveways, tennis courts, parking areas, garages, walkways, patios, loading areas, hard surfaces or other manmade improvements. Detention or retention basins shall be excluded from such calculations provided same is constructed of natural materials.

Maximum Disturbed Land Area shall mean all land outside of the

allowable disturbed areas shall be left in its natural state and no trees, shrubs, vegetated ground cover, top soil or other natural features shall be moved or altered.
