All dogs and cats six (6) months or older must be licensed every year.

- 1) You must send proof of rabies vaccination for the license to be issued. As per New Jersey State Mandate, the vaccination must not expire prior to November 1st, of the licensing year.
- 2) If your dog has been neutered/spayed there is a reduction in the licensing fees. Please enclose a copy of the neutered/spayed certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian.
- 3) Return this completed form with check or money order payable to the **Borough of Ringwood**.

Note - The late fee is waived if the owner is a new resident, has just acquired a pet, or the pet has just turned six months old.

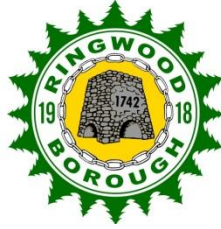
