## Accepts the following:

### Commingled Recyclables-

Aluminum cans, tin cans, steel cans, glass jars, bottles, and  
Plastics #1-7. No other plastics will be accepted

### Corrugated Cardboard

### Newspaper

### Mixed Paper/Junk Mail

### Scrap Metal

Appliances /White Goods (It is not necessary to remove Freon from appliances)

### Electronics

Tires (\$3.00 per car tire -\$6.00 per truck tire to drop off)

### Automotive Batteries

### Used Motor Oil

Leaves (must be debagged when dumped)

Small Brush (No larger than 2" in diameter and 4' in length)

Christmas Trees (the month of January only)

## Does Not Accept the following:

Construction/Demolition Materials (must make private arrangements for disposal)

Household Hazardous Waste (Call Passaic County Recycling Hotline at (973) 881-4506 for county drop off dates/locations)

Household batteries (The Passaic County Office of Solid Waste and Recycling is advising Municipalities to dispose of household batteries with solid waste)

Plastic Shopping Bags (The Ringwood Stop & Shop collects and recycles all plastic shopping bags brought there)

Rechargeable Batteries (Must be recycled as hazardous waste)

Florescent Bulbs (Must be recycled as hazardous waste)

Grass Clippings (Cannot be accepted per NJ Mandate)

Propane Tanks (Even if they are empty they must be disposed of as hazardous waste) - Look for propane tank exchange program

Antifreeze (Must be disposed of as hazardous waste)

Large Branches/Stumps/Logs (Can be brought to Skytop Recycling in West Milford or Sterling Recycling in Sloatsburg)
