PASSPORT DAY IN PASSAIC COUNTY

Paterson, NJ – Kristin M. Corrado, Passaic County Clerk is hosting two (2) special Passaic County Passport Day events in March. The first Passport Day will be held at the County Clerk's Satellite office located at 1237 Ringwood Avenue, Haskell (Wanaque), New Jersey on Saturday, March 1, 2014 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The second event will be held the following Saturday, March 8, 2014 at 401 Grand Street, 1st Floor, Room 130, Paterson, New Jersey.

The full names of the applicant's parent(s) must be listed on all certified birth certificates to be considered as primary evidence of U.S. citizenship for all passport applicants, regardless of age. Certified birth certificates missing this information will not be acceptable as evidence of citizenship.

In addition to this requirement, certified copies of birth certificates must also include the following information to be considered acceptable primary evidence of U.S. citizenship:

- Full name of applicant
- Date of birth
- Place of birth
- Raised, embossed, impressed or multicolored seal of issuing authority
- Registrar's signature
- The date the certificate was filed with the registrar's office
