

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6
FOR JAMES DRIVE SEWER PLANT REPAIR

WHEREAS, an emergency condition exists at the James Drive sewer plant; namely, damage to the baffle and scrapper mechanism; and

WHEREAS, a aforementioned condition presents an immediate and present danger to the public health and welfare and must be immediately addressed; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost to remedy the same will exceed the public bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-6 permits municipalities to award emergency contracts that exceed the bid threshold without public bidding; and

WHEREAS, engineering consultant, Gerard Fitamant, P.E. recommends that a contract be awarded to Coppola Services, Inc. to address the above stated issues;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth at length.
2. In view of the above mentioned emergency, an award of contract not to exceed \$30,000 is hereby awarded to Coppola Services, Inc. 28 Executive Parkway, Ringwood, NJ, without public bidding to remediate and rectify the aforementioned emergency condition at the James Drive sewer plant.
3. The Borough Manager is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents and take all necessary steps to implement the said contract.
