ANNUAL ANIMAL LICENSING COMING IN JANUARY 2027

Animal Licensing takes place during **the month of JANUARY**. Any questions regarding Animal Licensing - please call (973) 962-7079.

All dogs and cats 6 months or older must be licensed every year in Ringwood. If you no longer own your pet or your pet is deceased, please contact the Borough to avoid future mailings.

Why do I need to license my pet?

-  Easy identification to return pets to their owners
-  Helps control/prevent the spread of rabies
-  It's the law

-  **IMPORTANT REMINDER:** The Borough has ordinances against feeding any outside wildlife. Keep in mind feeding wildlife can put your domestic animals at risk if they drink or eat from the same dish or are bitten by a rabid animal, as rabies is transferred through saliva. Rabid animals will often vocalize, become agitated and aggressive. Please ensure that all dogs and cats are licensed and vaccinated against rabies. If you see an animal that is acting aggressively, please call the Police Department at (973) 962-7017.

CARE FOR YOUR SEPTIC SYSTEM

When septic systems are properly designed, constructed and maintained, they effectively reduce or eliminate most human health or environmental threats posed by pollutants in household wastewater. However, they require regular maintenance or they can fail. Septic systems need to be monitored to ensure they work properly throughout their service lives.

4 Things You Can Do to Protect Your Septic System:

- Inspect and pump out your system every three years.
- Use water efficiently.
- Don't dispose of non-biodegradable items or household hazardous waters in sinks or toilets.
- Care for your drainfield.

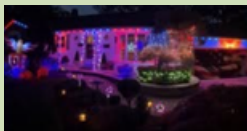

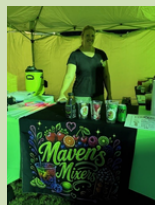

Tree Removal

Tree removal companies are required to be licensed by the State, and a tree removal permit must be approved by the Borough before any removal can occur. Yes, even if the tree is dead.

When selecting your contractor, trust your gut. Get the license number up front, and be sure that a permit has been obtained – you can check by calling or emailing the Building Department.

Emergency Replacement of Boilers, Furnaces & Water Heaters

The New Jersey Uniform Construction Code allows for the emergency replacement of boilers, furnaces and water heaters before a permit is issued as long as the Building Department is notified of the replacement prior to the installation and permits are submitted within three (3) days thereafter.

Get it inspected

"It's just a water heater, what's the big deal?" Actually, fuel-fired mechanicals pose a threat of carbon monoxide poisoning if not properly installed and vented. That's why you should set up an inspection shortly after the work is done.

Fall Fire Prevention Tips

As the weather begins to cool, here are some important tips to keep your home and family safe.

- * **SERVICE YOUR HEATING SYSTEM**
Have furnaces and heating equipment inspected before cold weather arrives.
- * **CLEAN CHIMNEYS & FIREPLACES**
Have chimneys inspected and cleaned before the first fire of the season.
- * **KEEP FIREWOOD AWAY FROM THE HOUSE**
Store firewood and other combustible materials away from your home's exterior.
- * **CLEAR LEAVES & DEBRIS**
Remove all dry leaves, pine needles and other combustible debris from around your home, deck and gutters.
- * **GIVE SPACE HEATERS SPACE**
Keep anything that can burn at least 3 feet away and turn heaters off when leaving the room.
- * **USE CANDLES WITH CARE**
Keep candles away from decorations, curtains and other flammable materials. Never leave them unattended.
- * **CLEAN YOUR DRYER VENT**
Remove lint after every load and periodically clean the dryer vent and exhaust system.
- * **PLAN YOUR ESCAPE**
Make sure everyone knows two ways out and choose a family meeting place outside.
- * **CLOSE BEFORE YOU DOZE**
Close bedroom doors before going to sleep to help slow the spread of smoke and fire.

Some Fall Tips & Reminders

-  **KEEP LEAVES OUT OF THE STREET**
Don't rake or blow leaves into the roadway. Leaves clog drains and create slippery conditions.
-  **KEEP STORM DRAINS CLEAR**
Clear leaves and debris from storm drains near your property to prevent street flooding.
-  **DON'T BLOCK DRAINAGE AREAS**
Keep ditches, culverts and drainage swales on or near your property free of leaves and debris.
-  **TRIM DEAD BRANCHES**
Remove dead or damaged branches before fall storms and winter weather arrive.
-  **PREPARE OUTDOOR FAUCETS & SPRINKLERS**
Disconnect hoses and winterize outdoor plumbing and irrigation systems before freezing temperatures arrive.
-  **CHECK YOUR MAILBOX**
Make sure your mailbox and post are sturdy and secure before winter and snow plowing season.
-  **CLEAN GUTTERS AND DOWNSPOUTS**
Remove leaves and debris to ensure proper drainage and reduce the chance of ice dams and water damage this winter.

Get your vehicles ready too!

-  **CHECK YOUR BATTERY**
Cold weather can weaken your battery and make it harder for your engine to start. Have it tested and replace it if needed.
-  **CHECK YOUR TIRES**
Inspect tire tread depth and adjust pressure for colder temperatures. Consider winter tires for better traction and safety.
-  **KEEP AN EMERGENCY KIT**
Include items like a blanket, flashlight, jumper cables, ice scraper, sand or kitty litter and snacks in case of an emergency.

Some Winter Tips & Reminders

-  **PARK OFF THE STREET**
Vehicles parked on the street prevent DPW crews from plowing curb to curb.
-  **GIVE PLOWS ROOM**
Stay well behind plow trucks. Never pass a plow. Roads are safer when we all drive with care.
-  **ADD PLOW MARKERS**
Add plow markers at the edge of your driveway or curb to help plow drivers see your property's curb line. Markers help prevent damage.
-  **KEEP CANS & BINS OUT OF THE ROAD**
Place trash and recycling bins at the curb, not in the street. Keep them out of the path of plows.
-  **BASKETBALL HOOPS**
Basketball hoops should be moved away from the roadway.
-  **DON'T SHOVEL INTO THE ROAD**
Shoveling snow back into the road creates hazards and slows plow operations. It is also against the law.
-  **KEEP HYDRANTS CLEAR**
After a snowfall, clear a 3 foot area around fire hydrants. Every second counts in an emergency.
-  **WAIT TO CLEAR YOUR DRIVEWAY**
Plows will push snow across driveway openings. Wait until the end of plow operations to clear the end of your driveway.

Don't forget your neighbors or your pets!

-  **CHECK ON YOUR NEIGHBORS**
Please check on your neighbors, especially seniors or those who may need a hand during snow events. A quick check-in can make a big difference!
-  **KEEP PETS WARM**
Bring pets indoors when it's cold. If you have an outdoor pet, make sure it is protected from the wind, rain, snow and ice. Ensure their shelter is insulated, dry and off the ground. Check them often to make sure they stay warm and comfortable.
-  **PROTECT YOUR DOG'S PAWS FROM THE COLD**
Ice, salt and chemicals can irritate paws. Wipe paws after walks and use pet-friendly balm or booties for extra protection on very cold or snowy days/

School Opens in September – Please Drive Carefully

As students head back to school, please use extra caution on our roads. Slow down, stay alert and help keep our children safe!



STOP FOR SCHOOL BUSES

Stop at least 25 feet away when a school bus has its red lights flashing



YELLOW LIGHTS = PREPARE TO STOP

Flashing yellow lights mean the school bus is preparing to stop. Slow down and be ready for the red lights.



WATCH FOR CHILDREN

Expect more children walking and biking, especially near schools, bus stops and intersections.



PUT THE PHONE DOWN

Keep your eyes on the road. Avoid texting, handheld phone use and other distractions while driving.



EXPECT MORE TRAFFIC

Give yourself extra time during morning arrival and afternoon dismissal. Don't let running late lead to unsafe driving.



OCTOBER – DECEMBER IS DEER RUT SEASON



Fall means increased deer activity on our roadways. During mating season, deer may move suddenly and unpredictably especially around dawn and dusk.

Here are a few tips for your yard sale:

- **START EARLY** - Have everything ready before start time. Many serious shoppers arrive early.
- **ORGANIZE BY CATEGORY** - Keep toys together, kitchenware together, clothing together, and so on.
- **DISPLAY ITEMS AT TABLE HEIGHT** - People are much more likely to browse tables than items spread on the ground.
- **MAKE SHOPPING EASY** - Have plenty of small bills and coins for change or offer mobile payment options (if you use them).

WHAT TO DO WITH UNSOLD ITEMS

Please donate, reuse and recycle before you toss!

-  **DONATE USABLE ITEMS** - Clothing, household goods, books, toys and furniture may be accepted by charities or thrift stores.
-  **OFFER ITEMS FOR FREE** - Post leftovers in local Facebook groups or at the curb stating "FREE"
-  **RECYCLE WHEREVER POSSIBLE** - Separate cardboard, metal, electronics, etc. instead of putting everything in the trash.
-  **DISPOSE OF ELECTRONICS PROPERLY** - TV's, computers and electronics should never be put in the regular trash. They can be brought to the Recycling Center or Passaic County's Electronic Collections.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I get rid of a large item, such as a couch, mattress, or dresser?

- You are allowed to put out one large, non-metal, item per week with your regular garbage. It must be less than 7 feet in length so it can fit into the truck. This DOES NOT need to be scheduled. *Please note that Interstate Waste requires mattresses to be wrapped in plastic.

How do I get rid of electronics, such as televisions, computers or printers?

- Electronics are not collected curbside. You can bring them to our Recycling Center ([click here](#) for days/hours) or you can bring them to any Passaic County Computer & Electronics events. You can [CLICK HERE](#) for their website to see upcoming events.

How do I dispose of paint?

- If it is latex or acrylic paint, you must dry it out completely, then it can go in a garbage bag and placed in your regular garbage. You can use cat litter to expedite the drying process. Oil based paint, spray paint, stains, varnishes, and thinners are NOT accepted in regular garbage. You will need to dispose of it through the Passaic County Household Hazardous Waste collections. We post these events on our website, but you can [CLICK HERE](#) for the Passaic County website to see what events they have coming up.

Can I put out construction material with my garbage?

- No. Items such as drywall (sheetrock), tile, masonry, wood and vinyl fence panels, roof shingles, and railroad ties are not collected curbside and must be disposed of privately.
- Toilets can be put with regular garbage.
- Carpet that is cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied can be put with regular garbage.
